Your rights. You can exercise the following rights:

1. right of access, which means you have the right to obtain from the controller confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning you are being processed, and, where that is the case, access to the personal data (Art. 15 of GDPR);

2. right to rectification, which means you have the right to obtain from the controller without undue delay the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning you. Taking into account the purposes of the processing, you have the right to have incomplete personal data completed, including, by means of providing, a supplementary statement. (Art. 16 of GDPR);

3. right to erasure, which means you have the right to obtain from the controller the erasure of personal data concerning you without undue delay and the controller shall have the obligation to erase personal data without undue delay when the request is legitimate (Art. 17 of GDPR);

4. right to restriction of processing, which means you have the right to obtain from the controller restriction of processing when the request is legitimate (Art. 18 of GDPR);

5. right to data portability, which means you have the right to receive the personal data concerning you, which you have provided to a controller, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and have the right to transmit those data to another controller without hindrance from the controller to which the personal data have been provided (Art. 20 of GDPR);

6. right to object, which means you have the right to object, on grounds relating to your particular situation, at any time to processing of personal data concerning you, including

profiling based on those provisions. The controller shall no longer process the personal data unless the controller demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override your interests, rights and freedoms or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims. (Art. 21 of GDPR);

7. right to withdraw consent at any time, that means you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal. Prior to giving consent, you will be informed thereof. It shall be as easy to withdraw as to give consent (Art. 7, point 3, of GDPR);

8. right to lodge a complaint, which means you have the right to the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority in case of unlawful processing of Data (Art. 13 point 2d of GDPR).
